#### LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY February 2015

- For February 2015, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **8,180**, down **184** cases compared to January 2015's **8,364** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for February 2015 are **3,324**, down **161** cases compared to January 2015's **3,485** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for February 2015 are **4,856**, down **23** cases compared to January 2015's **4,879** cases.
- Total support service payments for February 2015 totaled **\$365,350**, down **\$51,719** from January 2015's **\$417,069**.
- From December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2001 through February 28<sup>th,</sup> 2015, **3,063** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,839** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **782** of which were approved (for a **42.5%** approval rate).
