<b>About this report:</b>								
<i><b>Inmates</b> are adults in prisons, jails and work-release facilities. <b>Residents</b> are youths in Juvenile Services facilities.</i>								
<i><b>Employee</b> figures reflect testing conducted by DCR's medical services providers, and any offsite testing reported to DCR.</i>								
<i><b>Positive:</b> current (active) cases; NOT cumulative. All positive inmates are placed in isolation.</i>								
<i><b>Total:</b> cumulative tests; refers to number of tests performed and completed, NOT the number of inmates or residents tested.</i>								
<i><b>Pending:</b> all inmates/residents awaiting test results remain in isolation.</i>								
<i><b>Quarantine:</b> inmates/residents NOT showing symptoms but separated because they are new intakes, back from a hospital for unrelated reasons, etc.</i>								
<b>Inmate false positives to date:</b> BCC (1), CRJ (1), MCC (1), NCRJ (1), PHRJ (1), SCC (1), SCRJ (3), TVRJ (1). <b>Employee false positives:</b> BCC (1), NCF (1). <b>All false positives are moved from the positive/recovered columns to the negative column.</b>								
<i>For positive inmates eligible for release, all necessary notifications are provided beforehand. Such releases to date: <b>HCC (2).</b></i>								
<i><b>Testing</b> reflects decisions by DCR leadership and facility medical providers, following appropriate guidance and in collaboration with state and local public health authorities.</i>
