About this report: * This report has been corrected to remove an erroneous cumulative positive total for CCC.									
Inmates are adults in prisons, jails and work-release facilities. Figures for HCC and MOCC include their satellite work camps. Residents are youths in Juvenile Services facilities.									
Employees include contract and other non-state staff. These figures reflect all testing at facilities as well as all confirmed and recovered cases from offsite testing reported to DCR. Non-facility employees include parole officers and Central Office personnel.									
Active: current positive cases. All positive individuals are placed in isolation.									
Recovered: reflects CDC guidance, and for employee cases are determined by the facility's local health department.									
Pending: all inmates and residents awaiting test results remain in isolation.									
Total Tests reflects the number of tests performed and completed; an individual inmate or resident may be tested more than once.									
Quarantine: inmates/residents NOT showing symptoms but separated because they are new intakes, back from a hospital for unrelated reasons, etc.									
Inmate deaths (confirmed): SCRJ, 1; MOCC, 2. (Note: deaths of positive inmates are not included in this tally when medical opinion does not conclude COVID-19 caused or contributed to the death, and further medical determination is pending. Deaths not included per this criteria: MOCC, 5.)									
Total tests do not include several false positives received prior to updated CDC guidance: Inmates = BCC (1), CRJ (1), MCC (1), NCRJ (2), PHRJ (1), SCC (1), SCRJ (3), TVRJ (1). Employees = BCC (1), NCF (1).									
Testing reflects decisions by DCR leadership and facility medical providers, following appropriate guidance and in collaboration with state and local public health authorities. Among other circumstances, inmates are tested upon discharge of their sentences or when granted parole. All necessary notifications are provided when such tests are positive. Those results are not included in the above figures.
