- Are low in fat and high in fiber

WHAT YOU WILL RECEIVE

FOR MOM:

Grains

- 36 ounces of iron-fortified cereal

Vegetables and Fruits

- Two 12 ounce cans of frozen or two 11.5 ounce cans of shelf-stable concentrate Vitamin C-rich juice
- \$11 cash value benefit for fresh vegetables and fruits, canned fruits and vegetables, and frozen fruits and vegetables

Dairy

- 4 gallons of non-fat (skim) or low-fat (1%) milk
 - Allowable substitutions of cheese, yogurt or soy milk

Protein

- 1 dozen eggs
- Choice of: 1 pound dried beans or peas OR four 15-16 ounce cans of beans OR one 16-18 ounce jar of peanut butter

FOR BABY:

Infant formula

At six months of age

- Iron-fortified infant cereal
- Baby food vegetables and fruits
