# JOB DESCRIPTION FOR WV WIC BREASTFEEDING PEER COUNSELOR

Title: WV WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselor

### **General Description:**

A WV WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselor is a support person who gives basic breastfeeding information and encouragement to WIC pregnant and breastfeeding mothers.

#### Qualifications:

- Has breastfed at least one baby.
- Is enthusiastic about breastfeeding and wants to help other mothers meet their personal breastfeeding goals.
- Can work at least 8 hours a week.
- Has a telephone and is willing to make or receive phone calls from home.

## **Training**

- Attends a series of breastfeeding classes (nursing babies are welcomed) which includes a 16-hour competency-based USDA course overseen by the Local Agency Breastfeeding Coordinator (see Policy 11.01 WIC Training Modules).
- Observes other peer counselors or lactation consultants helping mothers breastfeed.
- Reads assigned books or materials about breastfeeding.
- Attends required Breastfeeding Peer Counselor trainings.

#### Supervision:

The peer counselor is supervised by the Local Agency Breastfeeding Coordinator.

#### **Specific Duties:**

The WIC Peer Counselor:

- 1. Attends the USDA breastfeeding peer counselor training to become a peer counselor.
- Counsel pregnant and breastfeeding mothers by telephone, other communication platforms, and/or hospital visits at scheduled intervals determined by the local WIC agency.
- 3. Counsel pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women in assigned WIC clinic(s).
- 4. Receives a caseload of WIC participants and makes routine periodic contacts with all assigned participants.
- 5. Gives basic breastfeeding information and support to new mothers, including telling them about the benefits of breastfeeding, overcoming common barriers, getting a good start with breastfeeding, and use of the Pacify App. Peer Counselor also helps mothers prevent and handle common breastfeeding concerns.
- 6. Respects each participant by keeping information strictly confidential. (see **Policy 5.20 Attachment #3**).
- 7. Keeps accurate records of all contacts made with WIC participants.
- 8. Refers mothers, according to clinic-established protocols, to the:
  - WIC nutritionist or breastfeeding coordinator.

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- Lactation consultant.
- The mother's physician or nurse.
- Pacify App
- Public health programs in the community.
- Social service agencies.
- 9. Attends and assists with prenatal classes and breastfeeding support groups.
- 10. Attends Local Agency staff meetings and breastfeeding conferences/workshops as appropriate.
- 11. Reads assigned books and materials on breastfeeding that are provided by the supervisor.
- 12. May assist WIC staff in promoting breastfeeding peer counseling through special projects and duties as assigned.
