B. Updates from the October 24, 2018 Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committee Meeting

Dr. Labus and the Board reviewed the updates from the October 24, 2018
 P&T meeting. No criteria changes were requested beyond those presented in section IV-C of this document.

C. PDL Prior Authorization Criteria (Attachment A)

- 1. **Entresto** Update criteria to reflect an AutoPA checking for age (over 18) and a diagnosis of chronic heart failure.
- 2. **Mitigare** Update sub-class criteria to apply to all agents, not just Mitigare.
- Tresiba & Fiasp Removed from Non-Preferred criteria as both agents will be preferred
- 4. **Lyrica CAPSULES –** Update sub-class criteria to apply to Non-Preferred Lyrica formulations (CR and Solution only) as Capsules will be preferred.
- 5. **Flector Patch –** Removed Non-Preferred criteria as agent will now be preferred. Changed quantity limits to maximum dosing of 1 patch per day.
- 6. Vimpat Removed the AP notation on Vimpat as it no longer applies.
- 7. **Glucocorticoid/Bronchodilator Combos –** Removed sub-class criteria. This sub-class will now follow the Class PA Criteria.
- 8. **CGRP –** Approved as presented (See attachment A)
- 9. **Epidiolex –** Approved as presented (See attachment A)
- Dupixent Approved with the addition of a requirement for eosinophils of ≥ 150 cells/mcL in asthma of eosinophilic phenotype (per manufacturer recommendation)
- 11. **Latuda –** Updated criteria to allow for a 30-day trial of EITHER Quetiapine OR a combination of Olanzapine and Fluoxetine, instead of requiring both.
- 12. Lucemyra The Board recommended updating the presented criteria to remove two items (If being requested for a scheduled withdrawal*, medical justification must be provided to support why an opioid taper cannot be used AND Patient must have documentation of a severe or life-threatening allergy to clonidine (reaction must be described).) The Board also recommended adding a requirement that the patient have a normal QT interval. Criteria was approved on condition these changes were implemented.
