5. Rule Language Discussion		
 M&S: Rule language was sent to workgroup last week. Any feedback? Agree to getting a smaller, technical group together to discuss specific cost report items in more detail. Discussed target adjustment and explained that the target adjustment is for a fixed budget value and that, if changed, the rates would adjust accordingly by finding a statewide percentage to apply across the board. Discussed UPL concerns and indicated that presently with the numbers that have been discussed (between \$360-\$380 per diem) we do not anticipate UPL issues with the caveat that CMS has not yet reviewed or accepted a PDPM UPL. Workgroup: Discussed concerns about specific cost report information and the need to talk through the finer points with a smaller, technical group.
