- Highlights included:
 - a. Four board member terms will expire on June 30, 2023. Per the Governor's office, others who are interested in serving will be considered as well as the members that are eligible for reappointment. Board applications will need to be submitted from all interested parties, including reappointments and WVAD recommendations.
 - b. WVCDHH is in the process of also becoming a Local Test Administrator for the EIPA to offer both the written and performance portions of the test.
 - c. New office computers were delivered and set up in May 2023.
 - d. The WVCDHH website and social media are updated on a regular basis.
 - e. On the WVCDHH Facebook page, we have gained 84 likes since March 2023 for a total of 1,608. There have been 1,741 page visits. The page reach is 15,951. Audience statistics Men 23.1% / Women 76.9%.
 - f. Deaf Awareness Day 2024 has been reserved and will be held on February 28, 2024. The date will be during the 2024 Legislative Session. The event will take place on both the Senate and House sides of the Upper Rotunda at the Capitol in Charleston.
 - g. WVCDHH is attempting to work with various universities in the state to start a new Deaf Studies program, which will focus on deaf education and interpreting.
 - h. WVCDHH is sponsoring a two-part virtual workshop presented by Allisun Kale. The first session was held on April 15, 2023, and the second session will be held on June 10, 2023. The first session had 92 people in attendance. The second session will be more interactive, so the attendance will be capped at 25-30 people, giving preference to WV interpreters.
 - i. WVCDHH is also sponsoring a virtual interpreting workshop on June 5, 2023. The workshop will be presented by Christine Mitchell.
 - j. WVCDHH hopes to sponsor, organize, and provide more workshops for interpreters and the Deaf/Hard of Hearing community throughout the state in the near future.
