What- National Influenza Vaccination Week is December 3rd-9th and while seasonal flu outbreaks can happen as early as October, flu activity is usually highest between December and February, though activity can last as late as May. If flu activity is ongoing, it is not too late to get vaccinated. Kanawha Charleston Health Department will be offering flu shots (Will bill insurance for flu shots) and educational material will be available for the public.
