

CALL TO ARTISTS Back To Life WV Cards of Hope and Encouragement

Project Summary: The BBH State Opioid Response (SOR) Program is working to launch Cards of Hope and Encouragement, a greeting card program for West Virginia residents. We are searching for West Virginia artists within the recovery community who are willing to offer artwork and/or words of encouragement and inspiration in the design of the cards. The greeting cards will be made available at no cost to West Virginia residents who are interested in supporting loved ones dealing with substance use disorder and their families.

Work Size: The printed greeting cards will be 5" x 7" and can be formatted either landscape or portrait. Each card will include artwork accompanied by words of encouragement and inspiration in ten words or less.

Entry Requirements:

- 1. Cover letter/bio describing your journey with addiction/recovery.
- 2. One to fifteen (1-15) digital images submitted on CD/DVD, thumb drive or jump drive mailed to the address below. Images should be saved in JPEG format with the image size set to 300 dpi resolution, 4" x 6" image size, approximately; AND/OR words of encouragement and inspiration to fit the dimensions stated above. Please limit this message to ten words or less.
- 3. Signed release to submit work Page 2 of this packet.

Entries Due: June 30, 2022

Selection Process: A panel of jurors made up of representatives within the recovery community across the state of West Virginia will review submissions and select those to be used on the greeting cards.

Notification To Artists and Individuals Submitting inspirational Messages: Selections and notifications will be made no later than July 15, 2022.

Publicity: The *Cards of Hope and Encouragement* project will be promoted through recovery partners around the state as well as distributed at in-person events.
