

10.02 Coordination Of Program Services

POLICY:

The West Virginia WIC Program shares certification information with health, education and welfare programs that serve WIC-eligible participants. The information is used to determine if WIC participants qualify for these programs and for outreach and educational purposes.

PROCEDURE:

The Local Agency will coordinate WIC services with other health, education and welfare programs according to the conditions outlined in the written agreements. See the attached agreements between the West Virginia WIC Program and the specific programs of interest for further details.
