

Instructions:

Length/height and weight measurements must be no more than 60 days old.

Length/height and weight measurements must be collected at every certification appointment and mid-certification appointment.

Hemoglobin must not be older than 90 days and must be reflective of the participants current WIC condition (or category).

The only exception to this is a child who is between 9 months old and prior to turning 13 months old.

This child's value will be collected as their infant stick.

A hemoglobin (hgb) measurement must be collected at every child, age 1-5, certification appointment.

A hemoglobin must be collected at the 18-month-old mid-certification appointment. This is considered their child stick.

A hemoglobin (hgb) measurement must be collected at every pregnant woman, breastfeeding woman, and/or non- breastfeeding postpartum woman certification appointment.

A hemoglobin value does not need to be collected if a breastfeeding woman is changing categories to a non-breastfeeding postpartum woman.
