

## LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### January 2022

- For January 2022, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **5,508**, down **52** cases compared to December 2021's **5,560** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for January 2022 are **1,391**, up **12** cases compared to December 2021's **1,379** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for January 2022 are **4,117**, down **64** cases compared to December 2021's **4,181** cases.
- Total support service payments for January 2022 totaled **\$126,755**, down **\$6,060** from December 2021's **\$132,815**.

From December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2001, through January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, **3,528** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit of that amount, **2,057** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **889** of which were approved (for a **43.2%** approval rate).
