

## **LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### **September 2019**

- For September 2019, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **6,471**, down **60** cases compared to August 2019's **6,531** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for September 2019 are **1,662**, down **22** cases compared to August 2019's **1,684** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for September 2019 are **4,809**, down **38** case compared to August 2019's **4,847** cases.
- Total support service payments for September 2019 totaled **\$229,334**, up **\$15,798** from August 2019's **\$213,536**.
- From December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2001 through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019, **3,389** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,991** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **858** of which were approved (for a **43.1%** approval rate).

- √ **4,809** Child-only cases ---- parents not in the home and children living with a relative, or parents in the home, are receiving Medicaid and are excluded from the WV WORKS payment.
- √ **35** Cases currently receiving WV WORKS and received TANF in another state before moving to West Virginia.
- √ **106** Cases where parents are excluded from the payment due to being convicted of a drug-related felony after August 22, 1996.
- √ **6,385** Cases receiving Medicaid but not SNAP.
- √ **200** Cases receiving SNAP but adults not receiving Medicaid.
- √ **270** Adults receiving WV WORKS and are employed.
