

## **LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### **November 2013**

- For November 2013, WV WORKS cases statewide increased to 10,278, down 82 cases compared to October 2013's 10,360 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for November 2013 are 5,229, down 78 cases compared to October 2013's 5,307.
- Child-only cases statewide for November 2013 are 5,049, down 4 cases compared to October 2013's 5,053 cases.
- Total support service payments for November 2013 totaled \$873,839, down \$5,662 from October 2013's \$879,501.
- The number of adult cases receiving WV WORKS for less than 12 months data has not been provided by RAPIDS since February 2012, due to data program changes.
- From December 1, 2001 through November 30th, 2013, 2,936 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,743 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 727 of which were approved (for a 41.7% approval rate).

- √ **5,049** Child-only cases ---- parents not in the home and children living with a relative, or parents in the home, are receiving Medicaid and are excluded from the WV WORKS payment.
- √ **10** Cases currently receiving WV WORKS and received TANF in another state before moving to West Virginia.
- √ **98** Cases where parents are excluded from the payment due to being convicted of a drug-related felony after August 22, 1996.
- √ **1,882** Cases receiving Medicaid but not SNAP.
- √ **76** Cases receiving SNAP but adults not receiving Medicaid.
- √ **1,168** Adults receiving WV WORKS and are employed.
