

## **LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### **January 2014**

- For January 2014, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to 9,356, down 862 cases compared to December 2013's 10,218 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for January 2014 are 4,424, down 762 cases compared to December 2013's 5,186.
- Child-only cases statewide for January 2014 are 4,932, down 100 cases compared to December 2013's 5,032 cases.
- Total support service payments for January 2014 totaled \$724,825, down \$139,695 from December 2013's \$864,520.
- The number of adult cases receiving WV WORKS for less than 12 months data has not been provided by RAPIDS since February 2012, due to data program changes.
- From December 1, 2001 through January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014, 2,961 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,752 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 736 of which were approved (for a 42.0% approval rate).

- √ **4,932** Child-only cases ---- parents not in the home and children living with a relative, or parents in the home, are receiving Medicaid and are excluded from the WV WORKS payment.
- √ **152** Cases currently receiving WV WORKS and received TANF in another state before moving to West Virginia.
- √ **112** Cases where parents are excluded from the payment due to being convicted of a drug-related felony after August 22, 1996.
- √ **1,845** Cases receiving Medicaid but not SNAP.
- √ **40** Cases receiving SNAP but adults not receiving Medicaid.
- √ **1,014** Adults receiving WV WORKS and are employed.
