LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY April 2023

- For April 2023, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to 5,162, down 31 cases, compared to March 2022's 5,193 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for April 2023 are 1,293, down 17 cases, compared to March 2022's 1,310 cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for April 2023 are 3,869, down 14 cases, compared to March 2022's 3,883 cases.
- Total support service payments for April 2023 totaled \$181,702, down \$9,421 from March 2022's \$191,123.

From December 1st, 2001, through April 30th, 2023, **3,585** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit of that amount, **2,083** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **893** of which were approved (for a **42.9%** approval rate).
