Dear Commissioner Beane:

I am pleased to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has approved your request to amend West Virginia's Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Aged and Disabled Waiver. The CMS Control Number for the amendment is WV.0134.R06.04. Please refer to this number in all future correspondence regarding this amendment.

This amendment adds 503 unduplicated participant slots to Year 5 of the current approved ADW Waiver application. This amendment updates (1) Appendix B Number Served, Unduplicated Number of Participants, and (2) Appendix J Derivation of Estimates, Number of Unduplicated Participants Served, and Factor D estimates for Waiver 5.

Estimated expenditures demonstrate that the waiver will remain cost neutral for each waiver year, as reflected in the estimates below. The effective date of this amendment is 07/01/2019.
