Procedure on glands that produce endocrine hormones
Procedure to close an abnormal connection between the intestine and the skin
Procedure uses a catheter with a one-way valve. Includes the necessary radiological supervision and interpretation, mapping and imaging guidance to complete the intervention
Procedure using a scope that is inserted into the mouth to the stomach and small intestine
Procedures on lymphatic system or blood. The lymphatic system controls fluids in the body
Procedures or services for allergies and/or immunologic
Radiation Therapy
Routine Foot Care
Sacral nerve stem test lead
Shoulder Surgery
Small ingestible camera to take pictures of the digestive and intestinal tract
Some types of cancer treatment
Spine Surgery
Stomach surgery
Surgery or treatment on feet, ankles toes
Surgery on intestine
Surgery on pancreas

Surgical implant of birth control
Surgical procedure to treat reflux -- Inpatient Hospital only
Surgical removal of birth control capsules
Surgical removal of cysts or lipomas
Surgical removal of tumor which is viewed under a microscope to see if any additional tissue needs to be removed
Surgical treatment to pelvis or hip joint
Surgical treatment to the sacroiliac joint

Surgical treatment to the sacroiliac joint --Inpatient hospital only
Surgically moving of fat, from one sight to another on the body.
Surgically removal of excess skin--possible cosmetic Tummy Tuck
Throat/esophagus surgery
Tissue transfer to a wound
Tonsil and Adenoid surgery
Treatment for excessive sweating
Treatment for fracture of the spine.
Treatment for neck muscles
Treatment of bone tissue in the hip
Treatment of the tailbone
Treatment on the nervous system
Use fat, skin or tissue to fill in an area that has a defect. Such as filling in a dip to make it even
Using skin near the wound to allow faster healing. The skin continues to receive blood.
Vaccine or toxoid-provides protective immune response
Vision therapy or surgery
