Duties include researching, analyzing and interpreting statutes, rules and regulations, policy, procedure and case law, and drafts and updates proposed legislation. The position will become familiar with all federal statutes, regulation and guidance related to Medicaid and CHIP. They also conduct legal research and provide advice on an AD HOC basis to BMS leadership and staff. The position will draft and file State Plan Amendments for West Virginia's Medicaid Plan and respond to FOIA requests. The position will also make recommendations to counsel concerning proper disposition of tax assessments or claims for refund, legislation, amendments to administrative regulations and the appeals of contested cases. As required, this position will engage in written and telephonic correspondence and complaints with various entities and the general public. Performs other duties as assigned.
