The Program provides in-home assistance with activities of daily living and other areas of personal need to help you stay independent in your home.

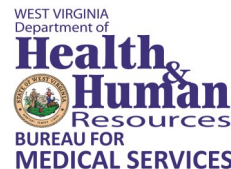

Facts about the Personal Care Program

The Medicaid Personal Care Program is an in-home care program. Certified direct care staff come to your home to assist you with your personal needs. In order to participate in this program, you must first be eligible for Medicaid and have a West Virginia State Medicaid card. Then, you must meet the criteria for medical eligibility for the program.



Application

You may contact a Personal Care Provider to inquire about application for the program. To find out who is a Personal Care Provider, go to the following:

Eligibility

Individuals eligible to receive this service must have a West Virginia State Medicaid card. When you first apply for Personal Care services, a Registered Nurse will contact you and your physician for an assessment for medical eligibility for the Personal Care Program.

To be eligible, an individual must have needs in at least three areas of activities of daily living. Activities of daily living include some of the following:

- Eating
- Bathing
- Dressing



Personal Care Services

A Personal Care aide is a trained care provider who assists you with services such as:

- Meals
- Grooming
- Mobility
- Toileting
- Other personal care needs.

Personal Care Services are provided in your home. Personal Care Services are supervised by a Registered Nurse.

Personal Care Services does NOT include:

- Skilled nursing care,
- Administer medications,
- Wound care,
- Injections, or
- Housecleaning as the ONLY service.
