A **3 day** food and water supply. For nursing homes, the food supply must correlate with a planned disaster menu.



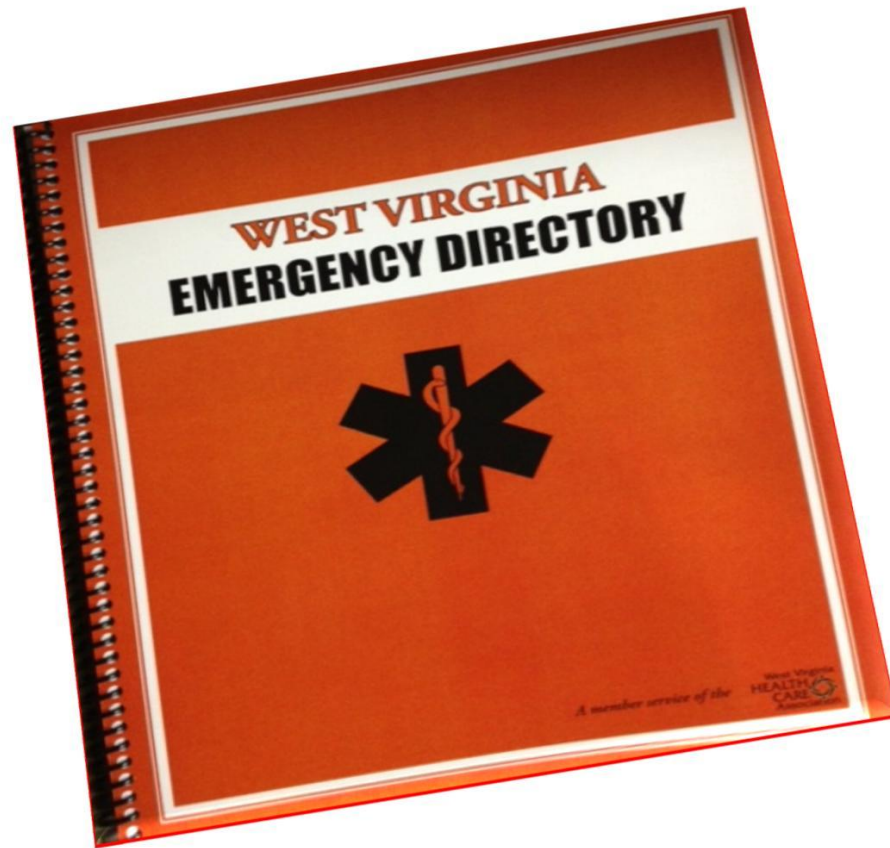




