



# Pipeline Emergencies

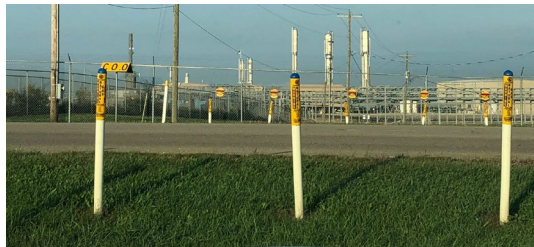
## 4-hour Training and Exercise

### **Course Description:**

This four-hour training is designed to comply with NFPA 470: Standard for Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials Incidents, specifically focusing on response considerations during pipeline emergencies. The course includes several case studies and a tabletop scenario. Topics include:

- Understanding how to obtain information on the National Pipeline Mapping System (NPMS).
- Understanding and Identifying what products move through your response jurisdiction
- Discuss first responder priorities
- Completing a pipeline scene size-up
- Working with pipeline operators, staff and contractors

Fire Service, Emergency Management, Law Enforcement, Emergency Medical Services, Hazmat Team Members, and Industrial Emergency Response Teams.
