## Instructions and Process of Application for Levels I, II, & III Recertification of Trauma Center Designation

- **Step 1** Facility **must** follow all American College of Surgeon-Committee on Trauma (ACS-COT) Reverification guidelines.
- **Step 2** Facility **must** apply for Trauma Center Reverification with ACS-COT.
- Step 3 Facility schedules a Trauma Center Reverification Visit with ACS-COT. Facility notifies Trauma Designation Unit of West Virginia Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS) of Reverification Visit date once confirmed.
- **Step 4** Facility submits copy of completed Pre-Review Questionnaire (PRQ) to Trauma Designation Unit of OEMS [within thirty (30) days of Reverification Visit].
- Step 5 Facility must submit completed Recertification Application, signed Letter of Commitment and Recertification fee to Trauma Designation Unit of OEMS at least ninety (90) days prior to their WV Trauma Center Designation expiration date.
- **Step 6** Facility **must** forward a copy of ACS-COT Reverification Site Visit report **and** Reverification letter upon receipt.
- Step 7 Trauma Designation Unit of OEMS reviews ACS-COT Reverification Site Visit report, Reverification letter and any additional information to determine Re-certification of Designation Status.
- **Step 8** Final Recertification of Designation Status letter is issued from the Trauma Designation Unit of OEMS within thirty (30) days.

<sup>\*</sup>If two facilities are filing for joint designation, each facility needs to complete a Recertification Application and jointly complete the Joint Center Supplement Recertification Application.
