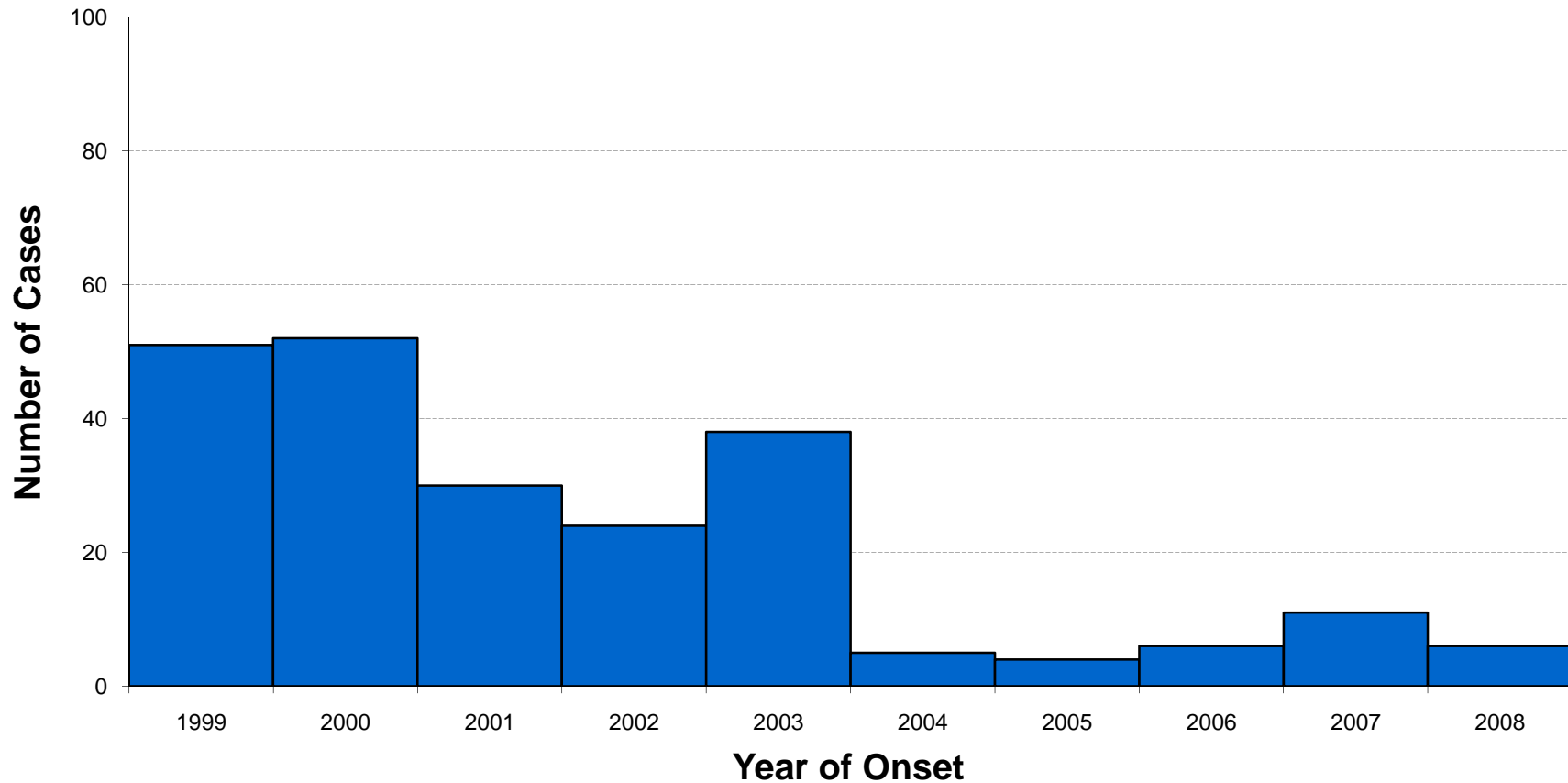
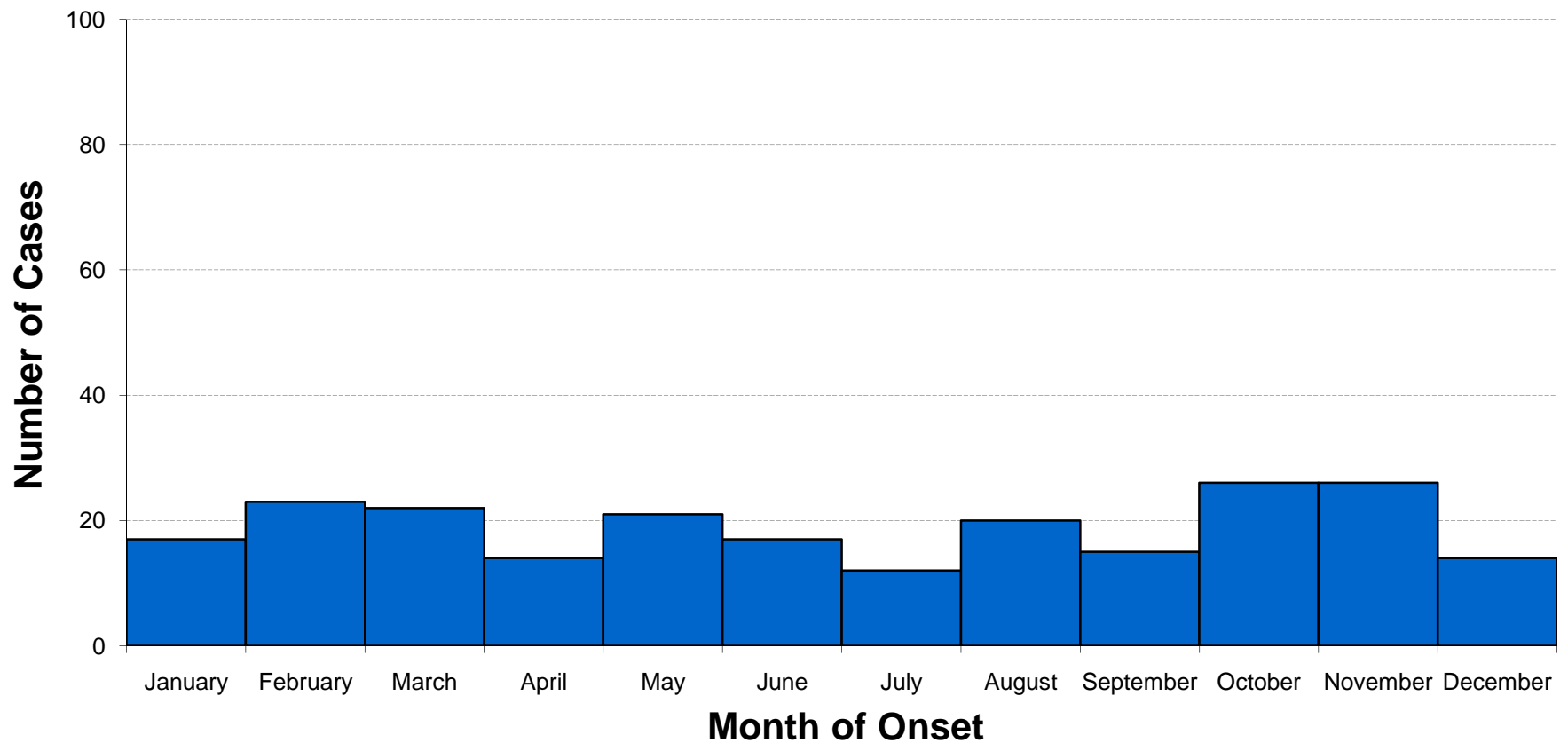


Reported Cases of Hepatitis A, by Year of Onset, West Virginia, 1999-2008, (N=227)



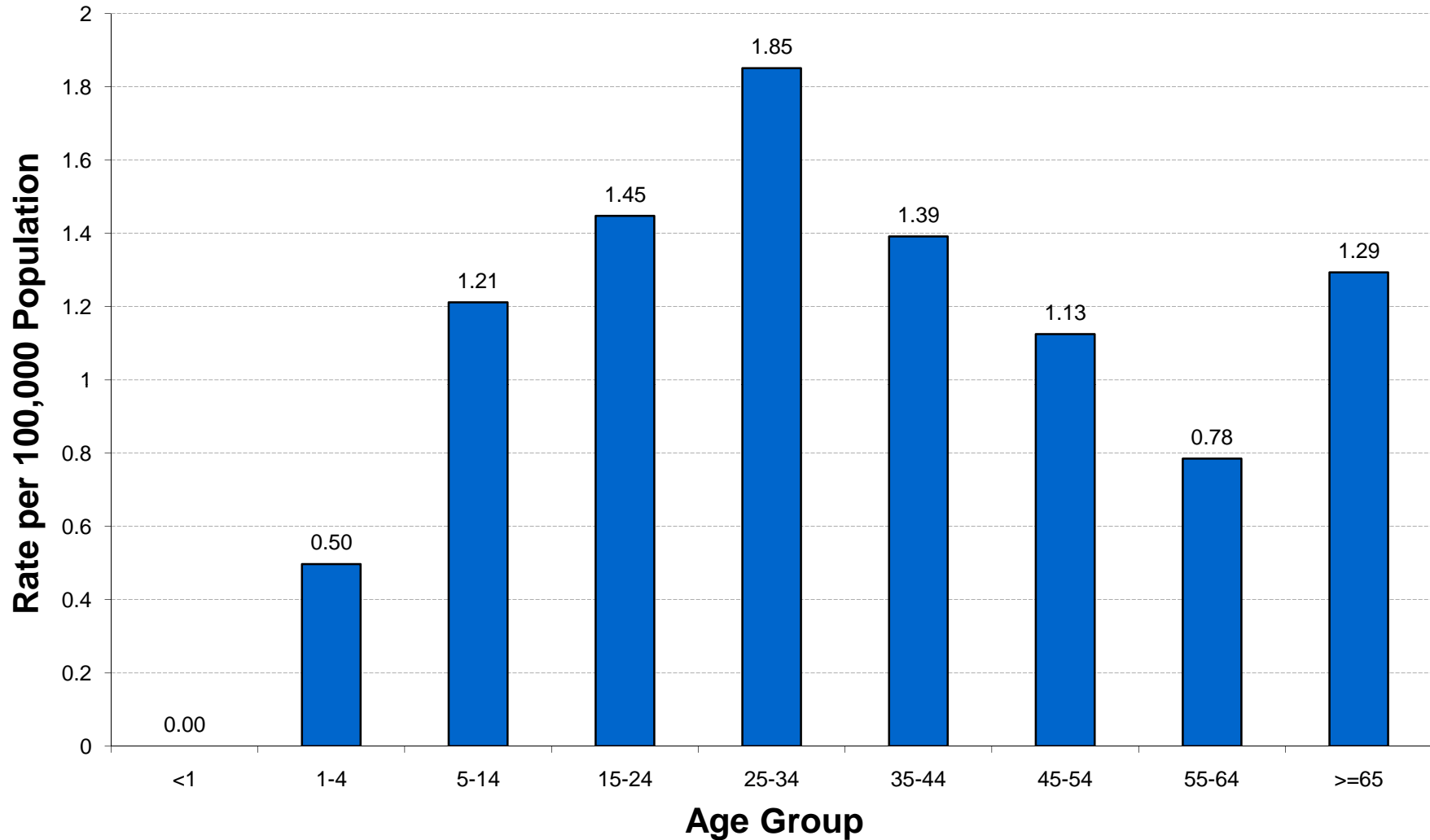
The increase in incidence from 1999 through 2002 is due to changes in disease surveillance practices.

The increase in incidence is due to changes in disease surveillance practices.

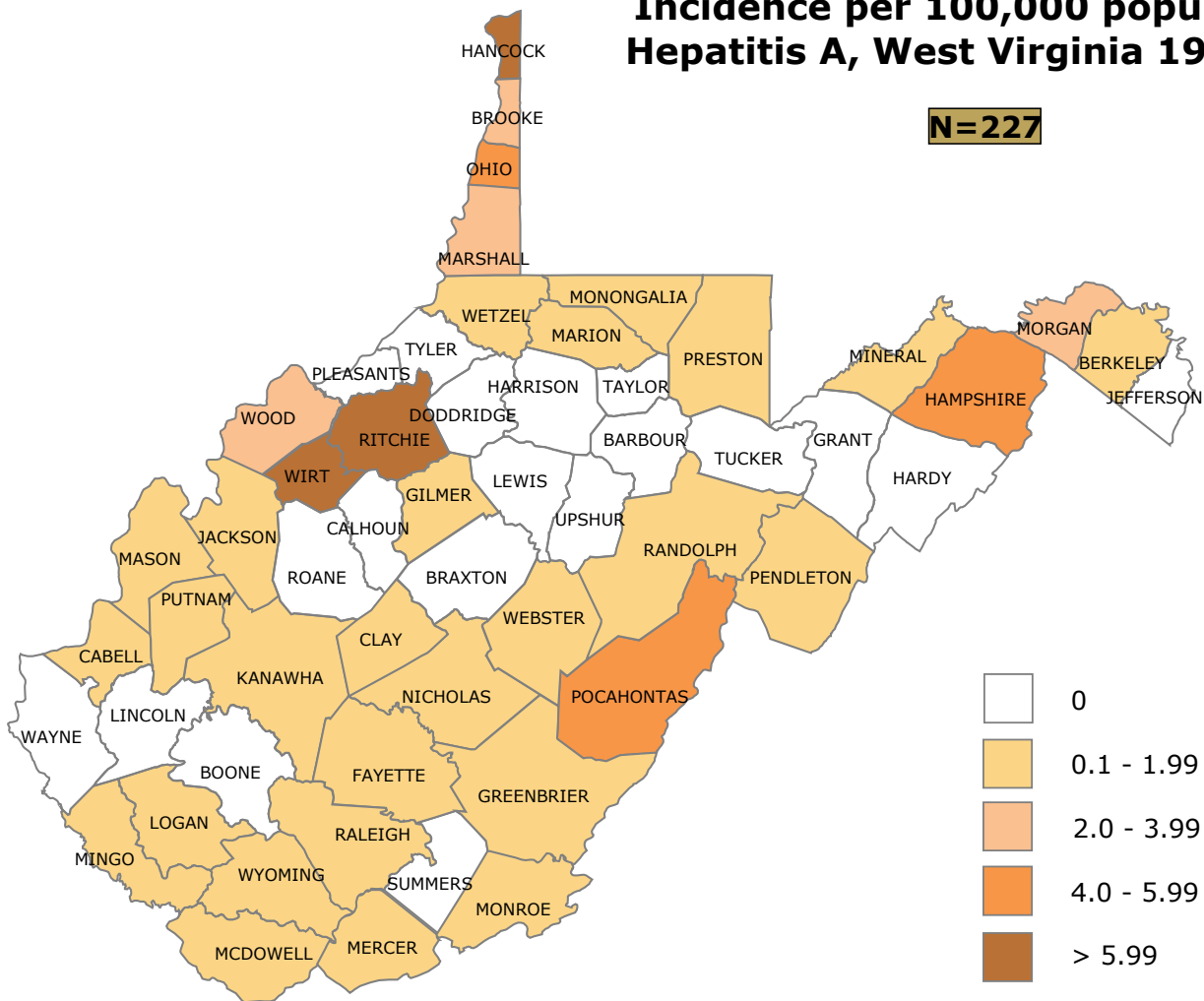
Average Yearly Age Specific Incidence* of Hepatitis A, West Virginia, 1999-2008, (N=227)
