# Opening:

# Agenda Items

#### Introductions and welcome - Dr. Matthew Christiansen

Dr. Christiansen gave the group an overview of how this workgroup came into existence and its purpose.

Next, workgroup members gave Mr. Cort and brief introduction of themselves and their role in the workgroup.

#### **Ben Cort of**

Ben Cort, CEO of The Foundry; Owner, Cort Consutling reviewed lessons learned from his state's implementation of recreational marijuana. The items of most concern to them had been:

- Potency manufactured formulations are much higher in potency than street-purchased marijuana.
- Edibles Are not properly broken down in serving sizes and are often diverted to youth.
- Economics Cost v. Benefit and the net gains or losses
- Enforcement of Regulations what will that look like in legislation and implementation.

The group discussed these topics and ways to address them.



#### **Open Discussion**

The group agreed that the work product from these meetings need to address the potential pitfalls and a strategy to limit the potency as low as possible.

The group discussed having Keith Humphreys for future speaking.

They also were to examine what Montana was doing along with any potential Colorado legislation.

Finally, the group discussed the implications of taxation.
