

## Parasitology: Session I, II, III Correspondence Course

### Who Should Enroll?

This course is designed to meet the needs of clinical laboratorians who examine parasites or who want a review of the subject. The examination of parasites is classified as high complexity according to CLIA regulations. Enrollees will most likely work in high complexity laboratories.
