Have you applied for Medicaid?

If you are on WIC or applying for WIC, it's a good idea to also apply for Medicaid.

What can Medicaid do for you?

Medicaid helps pay medical bills for pregnant women and children. It may be able to help pay medical bills that you already owe but have not been able to pay.

Whether you are Medicaid eligible or not depends on your income and other resources.

What you need to apply for Medicaid...

- 1. Proof of Income
- 2. Proof of where you live
- 3. The amount of your medical bills
- 4. A social security number for every person living in your home
- 5. Proof that you are a U.S. Citizen or lawfully admitted alien
- 6. If pregnant, proof of pregnancy

Where to go to get Medicaid...

To get Medicaid, you must fill out an application.

The people at your local Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR) can give you an application and answer your questions about Medicaid.
