LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY April 2014

- For April 2014, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to 8,998, down 105 cases compared to March 2014's 9,103 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for April 2014 are 4,107, down 78 cases compared to March 2014's 4,185 cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for April 2014 are 4,891, down 27 cases compared to March 2014's 4,918 cases.
- Total support service payments for April 2014 totaled \$833,767, up \$108,681 from March 2014's \$725,086.
- From December 1, 2001 through April 30th, 2014, 3,002 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,762 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 744 of which were approved (for a 42.2% approval rate).
