LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY April 2016

- For April 2016, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **7,418**, down **114** cases compared to March 2016's **7,532** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for April 2016 are **2,547**, down **135** cases compared to March 2016's **2,682** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for April 2016 are **4,871**, up **21** cases compared to March 2016's **4,850** cases.
- Total support service payments for April 2016 totaled **\$316,850**, up **\$5,664** from March 2016's **\$311,186**.
- From December 1st, 2001 through April 30th, 2016, **3,166** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,891** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **803** of which were approved (for a **42.5%** approval rate).
