LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY January 2013

- For January 2013, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to 10,488, down 114 cases compared to December 2012's 10,602 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for January 2013 are 5,522, down 113 cases compared to December's 5,635.
- Child-only cases statewide for January 2013 are 4,966, down 1 case compared to December's 4,967 cases.
- Total support service payments for January 2013 totaled \$971,008, down \$138,487 from December's \$1,109,495.
- The number of adult cases receiving WV WORKS for less than 12 months data has not been provided by RAPIDS since the February 2012, due to data program changes.
- From December 1, 2001 through January 31, 2013, 2,796 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,688 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 691 of which were approved (for a 40.9% approval rate).
