LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY January 2016

- For January 2016, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **7,626**, down **89** cases compared to December 2015's **7,715** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for January 2016 are **2,803**, down **79** cases compared to December 2015's **2,882** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for January 2016 are **4,823**, down **10** cases compared to December 2015's **4,833** cases.
- Total support service payments for January 2016 totaled \$331,633, down \$7,920 from December 2015's \$339,553.
- From December 1st, 2001 through January 31st, 2016, **3,151** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,884** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **800** of which were approved (for a **42.5**% approval rate).
