LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY January 2022

- For January 2022, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to 5,508, down 52 cases compared to December 2021's 5,560 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for January 2022 are 1,391, up 12 cases compared to December 2021's 1,379 cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for January 2022 are 4,117, down 64 cases compared to December 2021's 4,181 cases.
- Total support service payments for January 2022 totaled \$126,755, down \$6,060 from December 2021's \$132,815.

From December 1st, 2001, through January 31st, 2022, **3,528** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit of that amount, **2,057** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **889** of which were approved (for a **43.2**% approval rate).
