LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY June 2014

- For June 2014, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to 8,874, down 109 cases compared to May 2014's 8,983 cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for June 2014 are 3,985, down 80 cases compared to May 2014's 4,065 cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for June 2014 are 4,889, down 29 cases compared to May 2014's 4,918 cases.
- Total support service payments for June 2014 totaled \$873,959, up \$111,111 from May 2014's \$762,848.
- From December 1, 2001 through June 30th, 2014, 3,028 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,777 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 751 of which were approved (for a 42.3% approval rate).
