### LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY June 2016

- For June 2016, WV WORKS cases statewide increased to **7,490**, up **60** cases compared to May 2016's **7,430** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for June 2016 are **2,593**, up **38** cases compared to May2016's **2,555** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for June 2016 are **4,897**, up **22** cases compared to May 2016's **4,875** cases.
- Total support service payments for June 2016 totaled **\$428,387**, down **\$25,840** from May 2016's **\$454,227**.
- From December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2001 through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016, 3,184 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,904 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 806 of which were approved (for a 42.3% approval rate).
