LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY March 2016

- For March 2016, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **7,532**, down **125** cases compared to February 2016's **7,657** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for March 2016 are **2,682**, down **123** cases compared to February 2016's **2,805** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for March 2016 are **4,850**, down **2** cases compared to February 2016's **4,852** cases.
- Total support service payments for March 2016 totaled **\$311,186**, up **\$5,426** from February 2016's **\$305,760**.
- From December 1st, 2001 through March 31st, 2016, 3,160 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,890 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 802 of which were approved (for a 42.4% approval rate).
