LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY March 2017

- For February 2017, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **7,391**, down **146** cases compared to February 2017's **7,537** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for February 2017 are **2,369** down **135** cases compared to February 2017's **2,504** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for February 2017 are **5,022**, down **11** cases compared to February 2017's **5,033** cases.
- Total support service payments for February 2017 totaled **\$0**, down **\$0** from February 2017's **\$411,956**.
- From December 1st, 2001 through March 31st 2017, 3,233 WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, 1,927 customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; 820 of which were approved (for a 42.6% approval rate).
