LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY March 2019

- For March 2019, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **6,514**, down **119** cases compared to February 2019's **6,633** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for March 2019 are **1,531**, down **94** case compared to February 2019's **1,625** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for March 2019 are **4,983**, down **25** cases compared to February 2019's **5,008** cases.
- Total support service payments for March 2019 totaled **\$215,497**, down **\$8,038** from February 2019's **\$223,535**.
- From December 1st, 2001 through March 31st, 2019, **3,362** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,978** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **852** of which were approved (for a **43.1%** approval rate).
