LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY September 2021

- For September 2021, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **5,671**, down **58** cases compared to August 2021's **5,729** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for September 2021 are 1,410, down 20 cases compared to August 2021's 1,430 cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for September 2021 are 4,261, down 38 cases compared to August 2021's 4,299 cases.
- Total support service payments for September 2021 totaled \$122,275, down \$13,569 from August 2021's \$135,844.

From December 1st, 2001, through September 30th, 2021, **3,510** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit Of that amount, **2,047** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **881** of which were approved (for a **43.0**% approval rate).
