SUBJECT: Pause Payment Program for Provider Repayments

Due to the World Health Organization declaring Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) a pandemic, the West Virginia Bureau for Medical Services (BMS) wants to assist providers in these difficult, uncertain times. Our BMS Finance records indicate that you currently have a provider repayment agreement in place. This letter is to notify you that effective immediately, BMS is offering a Pause Payment Program related to provider repayments, regardless of repayment mechanism (recoupment against claim payments or check).

No payment will be due to BMS for the sixty (60) calendar days following the date of this letter, and no interest will accrue on your repayment balance during this time. Following this sixty (60) day pause, the repayment agreement currently in place will return to active status and you will need to restart repayments. A new repayment agreement will not be required.
