
RE: CMS-372 Annual Reporting for West Virginia's Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver (CMS Control #0876)

We have completed our review of the CMS-372 Report for the Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver for the waiver year ending January 31, 2013. Based on our review, we find the cost neutrality data acceptable, subject to any future data validation review. A comparison of the submitted waiver cost data to the corresponding cost of institutional care indicates that the waiver continues to meet the required §1915(c) cost-neutrality formula.
